
## Steeple Repair and Painting

id you notice three Jmen hanging precariously from the steeple lately? These "steeple people" have been giving the UMC of Hempstead church steeple much-needed paint and repair work. When they first began, a helicopter was needed to help hang the rope on top of the steeple spiral so they could do their magic.

The last time the steeple was painted was in the mid-1980s. It cost \$20,000 at that time.

Today, the job cost over \$40,000 to both paint and repair it. The steeple has a brand new look, and is once again a beautiful sight to behold. This project has depleted the


