"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight." (Proverbs 3:5-6)


Dear Sisters and Brothers,

I greet you in the name of our risen Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Two years ago, the United Methodist Church of Hempstead (UMCH) celebrated the 195th Anniversary of the establishment and growth of the Methodist Church in the Village of Hempstead. During the early stages of planning, it was agreed that we would have special activities to celebrate this milestone every five years. While this is great, I believe there is a need for us to remember this event every year.

The month of May is significant in the history of United Methodism. For example, the third Sunday is recognized by our denomination as Heritage Sunday. This day calls the United Methodist Church to honor its heritage by committing itself to the continuing call of God, remembering that the United Methodist Church was created by the union of the Evangelical United Brethren Church and the Methodist Church. It is very fitting that we observe our 197th Anniversary during worship on that same Sunday (May 19).

To say the least, we are part of a rich history and legacy here in the Village of Hempstead. To show our appreciation to God and to build on this legacy, I am asking that each member, family, and friend make a special contribution of \$197.00 or more to the UMCH. This contribution will be in addition to our regular tithes
