A Message from the Pastor's Desk




Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As promised in the September issue of the *Parish News*, I embrace this opportunity to share with you a little more information regarding Bishop Thomas Bickerton's organization of the New York Annual Conference (NYAC) churches into cooperative parishes.

According to Bishop Bickerton, one of the realities of this format is that it provides a more intimate setting for conversation and discovery. With this in mind, Bishop Bickerton has committed himself to a day of conversation with each pastor and local church/charge throughout the NYAC.

On Wednesday, December 18, 2019, the United Methodist Church of Hempstead (UMCH) will be hosting two cooperative parish gatherings. The pastors of the Western End Parish which consists of 11 congregations (UMCH included) will meet with the Bishop or a NYAC leadership team in the morning from 9:00 to 12:00.

The pastors of the County Line Parish which consists of 6 congregations will meet with the Bishop or a NYAC leadership team in the afternoon from 1:30 to 4:30. In the evening, from 6:30 to 9:00, Bishop Bickerton will meet with key leaders of the laity from the Western End and County Line Parishes. This will be a session where our Bishop will share information pertaining to growing concerns for the future of the United Methodist denomination. Also, our Bishop will seek feedback and input from each church/charge and their leadership.



For many years the United Methodist Church has been dealing with conflict over theological differences regarding homosexuality. By a slim majority, delegates at the General Conference session held this past February in St. Louis, voted to maintain the restrictions in the United Methodist Book of Discipline. This has resulted in protests and resistance by many churches.

I have begun the process of recruiting a few of the key leaders of the UMCH who can be present with Bishop Bickerton to hear information, discuss possible outcomes, and to share thoughts and feelings. Let us be in prayer for one another as we seek to come together to address those critical matters that affect the body of Christ called the United Methodist Church.

In the Spotlight






